COVID-19 Practices and Procedures

Pain Consultants of East Tennessee's first priority is the safety of our patients and our staff. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, we have been focused on mitigation efforts to ensure the safety of those in both of our practice facilities as well as the PCET Surgery Center.

Our practices and procedures related to mitigation recommendations from the Tennessee Department of Health and the Knox County Health Department have evolved as new guidance measures were initially required, some of which have changed as the months have unfolded.

As of the publication of this newsletter edition at the beginning of June 2020, the PCET Surgery Center is once again, fully operational following a previous mandate to temporarily suspend elective surgeries.



Pain Consultants of East Tennessee is also fully operational. Recommendations regarding mitigation efforts from the CDC, Tennessee Department of Health, and Knox County Health Department are still being enforced for our staff and all patients. The donning of face masks by patients is now optional.
