Choo Named MDC Community Champion

Dr. James Choo was presented with the Metro Drug Coalition’s “Commitment to Service” award at their 6th Annual Community Champions Award luncheon in early December.

The event, hosted at The Foundry at World’s Fair Park, recognized community leaders striving to make Knoxville and the surrounding area a safer and healthier place to live.

The “Commitment to Service” Award is presented annually to a person who is dedicated to giving back to the community, whether through their profession or volunteerism.

In presenting the award to Choo, Knox County District Attorney General Charme P. Allen (pictured to the left of Dr. Choo), noted his leadership in creating the MindfulnessTN conference, which brought the nation’s thought leaders in mindfulness meditation to Knoxville in 2016 and 2017. The conference promoted the scientific evidence that mindfulness and meditation practices help to decrease pain.



He was also noted for his role in creating the East Tennessee Opioid Conference in 2017-18 which aimed to educate primary care physicians and other health care practitioners about pain and addiction treatment.

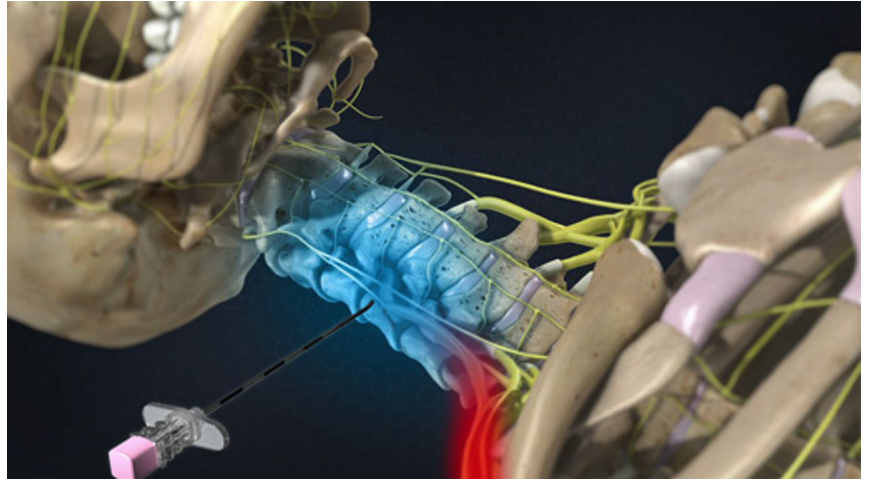
